Dear Head of Delegation or Team Representative,

Upon arriving to Samsun please follow the accreditation procedures according to this guide:

STEP 1: Delegation list & Arrival-Departure info check

STEP 2: Sports Entries info confirmation

STEP 3: Finances check

STEP 4: Accommodation check and room keys delivery

STEP 5: Accreditation cards delivery

Please note that the Accreditation Cards give you limited access until the CIC Check is done (within 24h after arrivals). The participants with the limited access Accreditation Cards are able to use catering, accommodation, training and transportation services.

STEP 5: Booking the FISU CIC appointment

STEP 6: FISU CIC appointment

The FISU CIC members will check the delegation members passports and checklist. After data approval and final validation of the Accreditation Cards by CIC, the Head of Delegation or team representative will receive the FISU hologram stickers for the cards.

The Head of Delegation will be responsible for placing the FISU Hologram stickers on the validated delegation members Accreditation Cards. Please note that without the sticker there is no access to the competitions.

MEDICAL UPDATE

Dear friends,

On behalf of the medical team of Samsun 2022 FISU University World Cup Combat Sports I wish you a safe and a very enjoyable stay in our city. We sincerely hope that your time in Samsun will not be overshadowed by any health issues. But should you wonder what capabilities we have, Ondokuz Mayıs University has a modern and highly equipped hospital and a team of experienced doctors.

We will set up an **infirmery clinic** with a dedicated medical team right **in the Athletes' Village**. Of course, special attention will be paid to COVID prevention measures. If you do not feel well and experience any symptoms of COVID (or need a fresh test before returning home), we invite you to make a **PCR test** right at our medical facility in the Athletes' Village. The price is **170 TL** (around 10 USD).

Please note that we will follow the guidelines of the Ministry of Health of Turkiye, so should the worst happen, and your test is positive (we hope it isn't), we will have **isolated rooms** and ready to admit you to the hospital. In any case, our medical team is always there to take care of you!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: Which airport should I book my flight to?

A: The official entry point is Samsun Carsamba Airport.

Q: Will anyone meet me at the airport?

A: Our transportation team and our volunteers will meet you and take you to your accommodation place.

Q: How can I exchange or withdraw cash?

A: The OC has made an agreement with YapiKredi and AKBANK, they will arrange temporary offices and ATMs in the Athletes' Village.

Q: What is the currency exchange rate in Turkiye?

As of 18 August, you can get approximately 18 Turkish Lira (TL) for 1 US Dollar.

Q: When can I get an invoice for an advanced team deposit?

A: The OC is preparing the invoices ; they will be sent ASAP.

Q: Do I need a visa to go to Turkiye?

A: Pleas check <https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/> and see if you need a visa and are eligible for an **e-Visa**. If e-Visa is not available for your country, please contact the OC at delegations@fisuworldcupcombatsamsun2022.com and we will prepare a letter for you.

Q: Where can I buy a local SIM card?

A: The OC is working with Turkcell, the largest mobile provider in Turkiye, to offer you a sales point in the Athletes' Village.





SAMSUN: A FOREIGNER'S PERSPECTIVE

For those who have never heard of Samsun, the upcoming event, without any doubt, will be an interesting and memorable experience. Here are some things which might surprise you:

Size. The city is really big: locked between the shores of the Black Sea and the foothills of the nearby mountains, the metropolitan area is more than 30 km long and counts more than 1,3 million people. The city tramway will carry you from the east to the west of the city, but **don't expect to use your Uber app** to find a taxi: it doesn't work here. Instead, local people use Turkish apps like Bitaksi. But it will be easier to find a taxi just in the street.

Culture. Like the rest of the country, Samsun is predominantly Muslim. Loud calls for prayer can be heard **5 times per day** starting from around **04:00**. Don't worry: they are very easy to get used to and won't disturb your sleep. For the same reason, don't be surprised not to see any alcohol in a local grocery store: even though it is not prohibited here, you should look for special shops with **Bufe** designation or big stores like **Migros**.

Food. There is no need to advertise Turkish cuisine. You will find yourself in a paradise for meat lovers. Samsun has restaurants and cafes in abundance.

People. Like in the rest of the country, people in Turkiye are very friendly and like foreigners. Don't be surprised if someone calls on you in the street and starts a conversation. However, in some cases their English will be limited by the phrase "where are you from?" and to continue the conversation, be ready to use **an online translator app** in your phone, you will need it all the time! Turkish people know how to enjoy their free time: they like family picnics and spend a lot of time outside.

Shopping. The currency exchange rate really makes shopping attractive here. Be sure to find time to visit Samsun's shopping malls, including a 4-floor **Piazza Mall** with dozens of various shops.

Nature. Do not forget to take your swimsuit. September is the best season here and the sea will be very warm.

Warning: beware Turkish drivers! Pedestrians must be careful while crossing streets.





BOXING: SPORT ENTRY CHECK

Each University that has entered boxers will need a maximum 2 (1 coach/1 manager) to attend the **Sports Entry Check** and present:

- The boxers' **passport**;
- The boxers' **medical record book** with photo and appropriately signed;
- The **IBA Medical Certificate** completed within 3 months of the Sports Entry Check duly stamped by the doctor and passed as 'Fit to Box' (see IBA Rules Annex 5);
- Signed **non-pregnancy form** for each female boxer (see IBA Rules Annex 7);
- Signed **Anti-Doping form** (see IBA Rules Annex 6);
- A copy of the **consent form** from **an Orthodontist** where the boxer wears teeth braces (see IBA Rule 4.2.5.2.8);
A copy of the **consent form** from the practitioner where a boxer has had **eye laser surgery** (see IBA Rule 4.2.5.2.6);
- An **example of the male and female boxers uniforms** the athlete will wear. If an athlete wears a hijab, this must also be inspected for compliance.
