GENERAL INFORMATION

The **FISU University World Cups** are the university sport's newest event properties, created to complement the FISU World University Games and the FISU World University Championships. The cup embraces a **university-versus-university format** instead of national delegations. Putting on university colours and competing amongst classmates at an international level, is an experience that cannot be found anywhere else in sports.

The mission of the FISU University World Cups is to help bring ever more student-athletes into the fold.

For 2022 FISU has introduced yet another innovation: for the first time one city will host as many as 6 sports, making Samsun 2022 FISU University World Cup Combat Sports Samsun **the first FISU multisport event** since 2019 Summer Universiade.

The University Sports Federation of Türkiye has a vast experience of organising FISU events, including memorable 2005 Summer Universiade Izmir, 2011 Winter Universiade Erzurum and as many as 11 World University Championships.

- a) Be a student of the university (no matters the nationality) they represent;
- b) Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event; for 2022.

Athletes must be born between the 01/01/1997 and the 31/12/2004.

Note that a special age bracket applies to Boxing: Be at least 19 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the year of the event; for 2022, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1997 and the 31/12/2003.

The participation fee is 70 EUR per participant per night

Note: this does not include FISU registration fee

HOST CITY

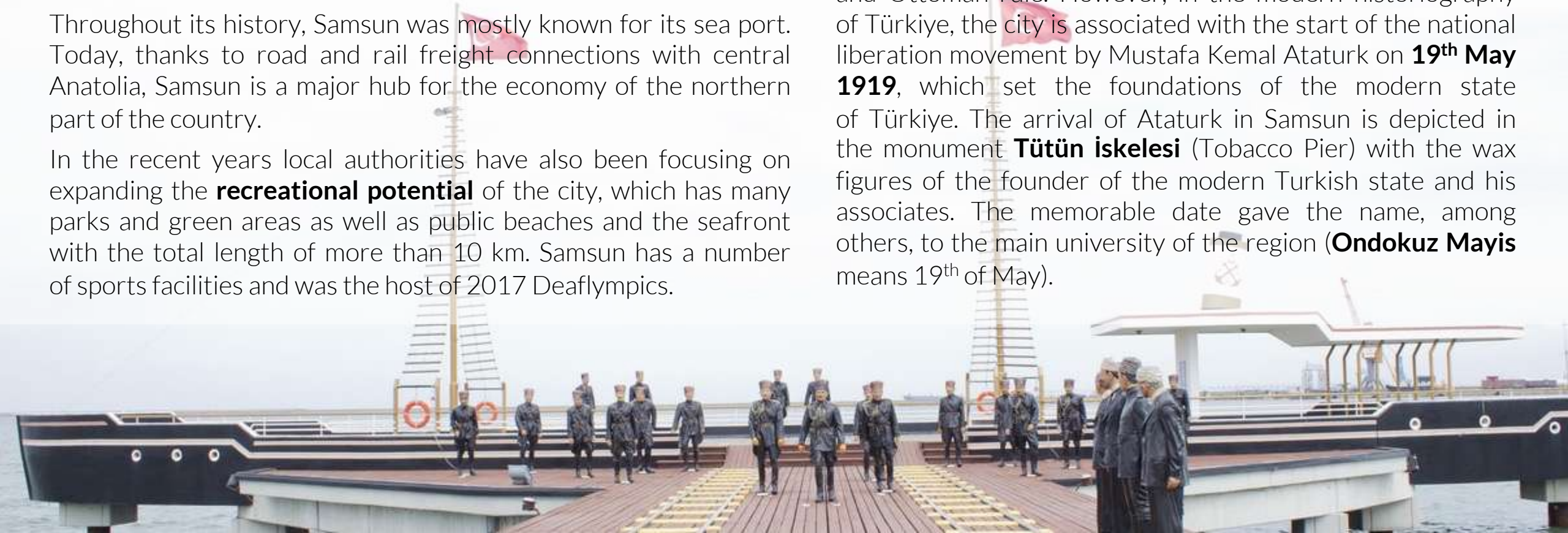
Samsun is a city on the north coast of Türkiye. In 2020, Samsun recorded a population of 710,000 people. The city is the provincial capital of Samsun Province which has a population of 1,356,079. The city is home to **Ondokuz Mayıs University**, several hospitals, three large shopping malls, Samsunspor FC, an opera and a large and modern manufacturing district.

Throughout its history, Samsun was mostly known for its sea port. Today, thanks to road and rail freight connections with central Anatolia, Samsun is a major hub for the economy of the northern part of the country.

In the recent years local authorities have also been focusing on expanding the **recreational potential** of the city, which has many parks and green areas as well as public beaches and the seafront with the total length of more than 10 km. Samsun has a number of sports facilities and was the host of 2017 Deaflympics.

Climate in Samsun in August/September is about 28 degrees Celsius (82 Fahrenheit) during the day and around 24 degrees at night, rather humid.

The history of Samsun dates back to the VIII century BC. In the following period the city lived under the Greek, Roman and Ottoman rule. However, in the modern historiography of Türkiye, the city is associated with the start of the national liberation movement by Mustafa Kemal Atatürk on **19th May 1919**, which set the foundations of the modern state of Türkiye. The arrival of Atatürk in Samsun is depicted in the monument **Tütün iskelesi** (Tobacco Pier) with the wax figures of the founder of the modern Turkish state and his associates. The memorable date gave the name, among others, to the main university of the region (**Ondokuz Mayıs** means 19th of May).



VISA REQUIREMENTS

Türkiye belongs to some of the world's most tourist-friendly countries; citizens of many countries are exempted from visa for their travels up to 30 days, 60, 90 or even 180 (in some cases) days.

We recommend that you check if visa exceptions are applicable to your country at the consulate section of Türkiye Embassy of your country. Information can also be found at Türkiye's MFA [website](#).

Should you need to obtain visa, the e-Visa (Republic of Türkiye Electronic Visa Application System) is an alternative to visas issued at Turkish missions and at the ports of entry.

E-Visa is an official document permitting entry into and travel within Türkiye. This system allows to easily obtain e-Visas online (www.evisa.gov.tr)

It is possible to obtain e-Visa 7/24 at any place with internet connection. The applicants can obtain their visa after they fill in the necessary information concerning their identity, passport and travel dates and pay visa fee online.

We strongly recommend that you have a travel document/passport valid for at least 6 months as from the date of your arrival in Türkiye.

BOXING

The boxing competitions shall be organised in accordance with the most recent IBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules (IBA Technical & Competition Rules) of the International Boxing Association (IBA) unless otherwise stated. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

All boxers participating in the Samsun 2022 FISU University World Cup Combat Sports must be born between 01/01/1997 and 31/12/2003.

The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC. The competitions shall last six days and include individual events in the following weight categories:

Each boxer must have a valid IBA medical record book.

Boxer quota

Each university is authorised to enter up to 13 competitors (7 men and 6 women with a maximum of 1 athlete per weight category) and 5 officials.

Each delegation can have the following number of officials:

- 1 athlete: 1 official
- 2 to 5 athletes: up to 2 officials
- 6 to 13 athletes: up to 3 officials

A country can be represented in each weight category by a maximum of two different universities.

The function of the sport's official can be Coach, Team Leader, Team Official, Doctor and Medical Personnel. Universities shall declare their starters to the Technical Committee at the latest 24 hours before the General Weigh-In.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

KARATE

The Karate competitions shall be organised in accordance with the current World Karate Federation (WKF) rules. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative. The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC.

The competitions shall last 4 days and include:

Kumite

I. Individual events:

Each university is authorised to enter a maximum of 1 competitor in each weight category. A country can be represented in each weight category by a maximum of 2 different universities.

II. Team events

Men: a team comprises maximum 7 and minimum 5 members with 5 competing in a round.

Women: a team comprises maximum 4 and minimum 3 competing in a round.



KARATE

Kata

Men and women:

- Individual events: 1 competitor
- Team events: 3 competitors

Karate quota: Each university is authorised to enter a maximum of 29 competitors (16 men and 13 women) and maximum 4 officials.

Each delegation can have the following number of sport officials:

- 1 athlete: 1 official
- 2 to 5 athletes: up to 2 officials
- 6 to 15 athletes: up to 3 officials
- 16 to 29 athletes: up to 4 officials

The function of the sport's official can be Coach, Team Leader, Team Official, Doctor and Medical Personnel. The team events shall take place after the individual events.

In the bouts for medals in Team Kata Competition, the total time allowed for the Kata and Bunkai (demonstration) is 5 minutes. Each athlete and coach must be able to provide evidence of WKF membership and coaches must be at least WKF accredited. At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

The programme and duration of the competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC. The competitions shall last 6 days and include the following events:

The duration of each bout shall be 3 rounds of 3 minutes each for both male and female competitors. A full 1 minute of rest shall be given between the rounds.

Each delegation can have the following number of sport officials:

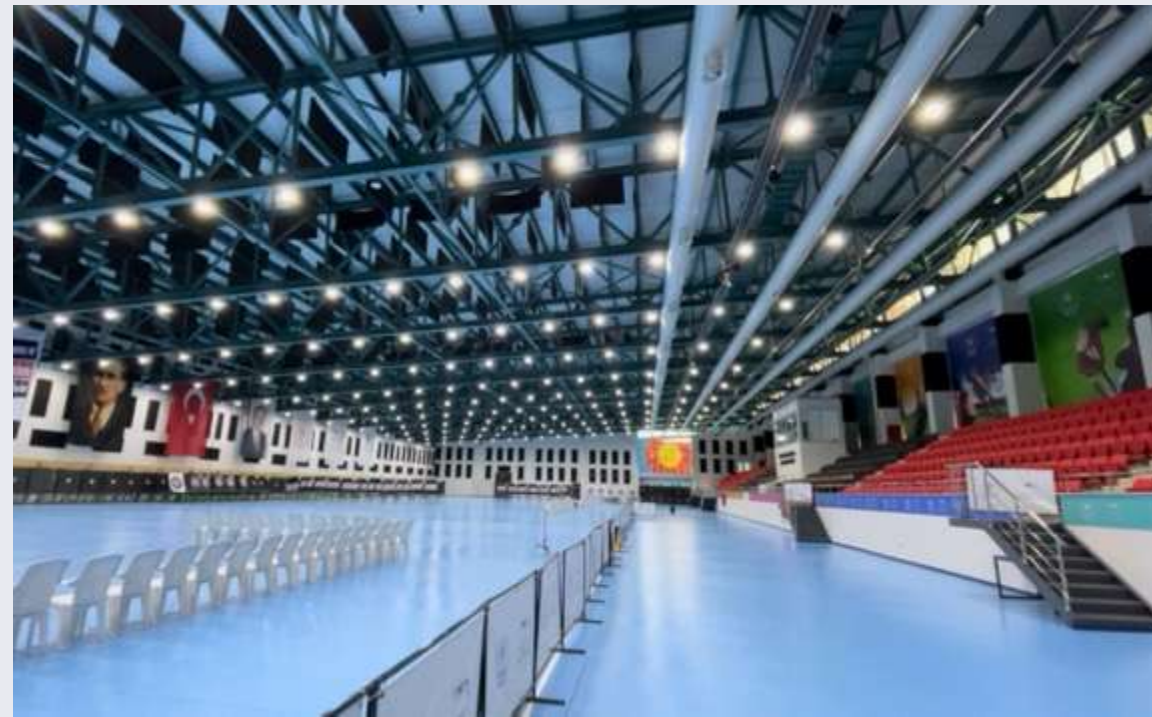

The SAMBO competitions will be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the “Fédération Internationale de Sambo” (FIAS). In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text will be regarded as authoritative. The programme and duration of the competitions are fixed by the FISU Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC. The competitions shall last 3 days and include the following individual events:

SAMBO quota

Each university is authorised to enter up to 14 competitors (7 men and 7 women with a maximum of one athlete per weight category) with maximum 3 officials.

Each university can be represented in the individual categories by: maximum of 1 SAMBO player per weight category;

Mixed team can be composed of maximum 10 athletes – 5 men and 5 women, minimum 6 athletes.

The teams must be composed of competitors who are also participating in the individual categories.

A country can be represented in each weight category by a maximum of 2 different universities.

Each delegation can have the following number of sport officials:

- 1 athlete: 1 official
- 2 to 5 athletes: up to 2 officials
- 6 to 14 athletes: up to 3 officials

The function of the officials can be Coach, Team Leader, Team Official, Doctor and Medical Personnel. Universities shall declare their starters to the Technical Committee at the latest 24 hours before the General Weigh-In. At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

The wrestling competitions shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the “United World Wrestling” (UWW). In any dispute the French text shall be regarded as authoritative. The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC. The competitions shall last five days and include individual events in the following weight categories:

A country can be represented in each weight category by a maximum of 2 different universities. The universities shall declare their starters to the Technical Committee 6 hours before the official draw (until 12:00 pm in the drawing day).

Each delegation can have the following number of sport officials:

- 1 athlete: 1 official
- 2 to 5 athletes: up to 2 officials
- 6 to 15 athletes: up to 3 officials
- 16 to 30 athletes: up to 4 officials.

The function of the officials can be Coach, Team Leader, Team Official, Doctor and Medical Personnel. At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

WUSHU

The Wushu competitions shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the International Wushu Federation (IWUF), IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules & Judging Methods (Excerpt) 2019 and IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Methods 2017.

In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the UWC ITC. The competitions shall last 4 days and include the following events:

The duration of events is as follows for both men and women.

Taolu (Routines)

- For Changquan, Daoshu, Gunshu, Jianshu, Qiangshu, Nanquan, Nangun & Nandao, each routine's duration shall be no less than 1 minute and 20 seconds.
- For Taijiquan and Taijijian, each routine's duration shall be between 3 to 4 minutes.

Sanda (Free Fighting)

Each bout consists of 3 rounds of 2 minutes with a 1 minute rest in between.

An athlete will be determined to have won a bout by winning 2 rounds; or by knock-out of his/her opponent; or by technical victory as stipulated in the "Rules for International Wushu Sanda Competition".

Wushu quota: Each university is authorised to enter up to 12 competitors (6 men and 6 women with a maximum of 1 athlete per weight category) and 3 officials.

A country can be represented in each weight category by a maximum of two different universities.

Each delegation can have the following number of officials:

- 1 athlete: 1 official
- 2 to 6 athletes: 2 officials
- 7 to 12 athletes: 3 officials

The function of the officials can be Coach, Team Leader, Team Official, Doctor and Medical Personnel. Athletes: 6 taolu athletes (3 men and 3 women, maximum 1 athlete per medalling taolu event) and 6 sanda athletes (maximum 1 athlete per weight division, with a limit of 3 male and 3 women in total). At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors.

ACCOMMODATION



Athletes will be accommodated as 2-3 people in the rooms at the Ondokuz Mayıs University dormitory, which was constructed in 2017 and served as the athletes' village for 2017 Deaflympics. Every room has a WC, a shower and all necessary equipment.

The dormitory building is within walking distance of the campus cluster (Yaşar Doğu Sport Centre and Yalcin Tasmektepligil Sports Centre, which will host Karate, Wushu and Boxing). The accreditation centre is within the walking distance too. You can find more pictures and information [here](#).

TRANSPORTATION

During the event, transportation services for the participants of the Samsun 2022 FISU University World Cup Combat Sports will be mainly offered through the tramway system of Samsun. Tram stops are within walking distance of the accommodation and sports halls. Trams run every 15 minutes and operate from 6.15 am to 11.30 pm.

All participants will be able to use the tram service with their accreditation cards free of charge.

The airport transfers will be arranged through the shuttle buses.

The logistics of the event will be centered around two main clusters: the University campus, where Athletes' Village, Accreditation Centre as well as venues for Boxing, Karate and Wushu will be located (upper left corner of the map), and the sports cluster in Ilkadim District with the venues for Wrestling, Sambo and Muaythai. The transportation between the clusters will be carried out by the city tramway system.



FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Türkiye is famous for its cuisine and Samsun is no exception.

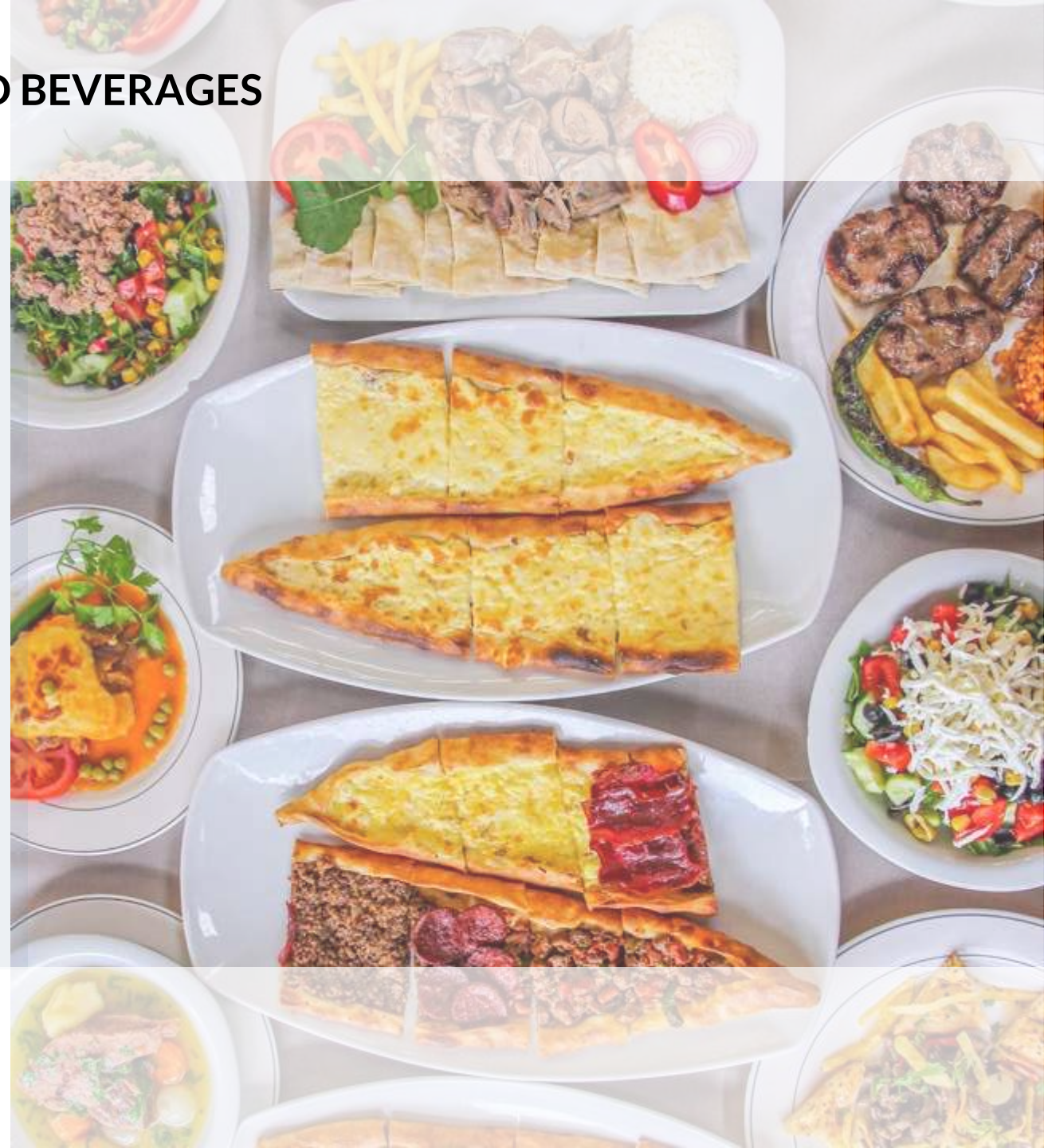
Athletes' Village Cafeteria will offer five types of menu with such options as halal, vegetarian, vegan, local, and Asian. Gluten-free, lactose-free or both gluten-free and lactose-free options will be available too.

The breakfast will be served in the Athletes' Village cafeteria from 07:00 to 09:00.

The lunch for participants of Boxing, Karate and Wushu will also be provided in the Athletes' Village. For Wrestling, SAMBO and Muaythai participants a special dining area will be organised between the corresponding venues.

The lunch will be served from 12:00 to 14:00.

The dinner will be served at the Athletes' Village cafeteria from 18:30 to 21:00.



FINANCE

The participation fee for the organization is **70 EUR per person per night**. This fee includes 3 meals, accommodation and transfer (airport – accommodation, accommodation – sports venues and back). **Note:** FISU registration fee is not included and needs to be paid separately

The universities/NUSFs shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to the nearest official point of entry (approved by FISU) of the World Cup and return. The designated airport or other entry point must be approved by the FISU University World Cups Department.

Any partial or complete withdrawal unannounced by a NUSF to the Organizing Committee and the World Cups Department or announced less than a week prior to the start of the competition and causing extra costs to the Organizing Committee can be charged at the price of 70 EUR/night/person.

It is mandatory for delegations to pay the participation fee to the Organizing Committee. If delegations refuse, they are excluded from the competition and will not receive accreditation.

Participating universities must confirm their entry with an advance payment of 25% of the accommodation costs per competitor entered.

The deposit, which guarantees an entry, shall be directly collected by the Organizing Committee.

The delegations will have to cover the costs of the ITOs for the following sports: Boxing, Karate, Sambo, Wrestling.
